

Oral Mucosal Pigmented Nevus of Palatal Gingiva; A Case of Report

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Abstract

A pigmented nevus is defined a proliferation of melanin producing cells as a hamartoma. The disease with involvement of the oral mucosa is relative rare. 41-year-old man referred to our clinic from dental practitioner. He had a gingival mass with small brown spot in the palatal gingiva of right upper incisor. Pathology after biopsy was pigmented nevus, intradermal type.
